

THE HAVANESE

EARS – set relatively high
pendant - well feathered

STOP –moderate

EYES - large, dark, almond
Kind, gentle expression

MUZZLE- neither snipey
nor truncated

TEETH – scissors bite
Full dentition desirable

FORELEGS – lean, straight,
parallel – good bone structure

TEMPERAMENT – cheerful,
intelligent , playful – lively
companion - Child's playmate

COAT – long, abundant, soft,
light - Untrimmed - Simply
groomed - not obscuring outline

SKULL - Broad - flat to
Slightly rounded

TOPLINE - straight

LOIN
sl. arched

BODY – Slightly longer
than tall – rectangular outline

TAIL - well feathered
curled over the back

HINDQUARTERS – good bone
structure – moderately angled
Straight and parallel

HEIGHT 23 – 27cm (9-10.6")
TOLERANCE 21-29cm (8.3-11.4")

SUBSTANCE – small but sturdy
Not fragile or coarse

GAIT – lively and elastic, light
footed - natural speed and gait
free stride - strong rear provides
impulsion
